
This guide follows the processing and practical task workflows of fluorocarbon recovery operators summarizing the necessary information (5 roles). More detailed explanations can be accessed using the Two-dimensional codes shown for each item.

## Roles Performed by Fluorocarbon Recovery Operators in Automotive Recycling

- When recovering fluorocarbons from End-of-Life Vehicles (ELVs), recovery must be carried out in compliance with the Act on Recycling of End-of-Life Automobiles (ELV Recycling Law).
  - Violating the ELV Recycling Law will result in penalties such as fines and imprisonment. [Chapter VIII]
- Registration with the local government is required in order to carry out fluorocarbon recovery operations for ELVs. [Chapter III, Section 2]

## Practical Tasks Performed by Fluorocarbon Recovery Operators in Automotive Recycling (Recommended Procedures)

## Role 1

1. Collect the vehicle and check its chassis number.

Confirm that the vehicle's equipment matches the information in the report on movements.

2. Person in charge of report on movements reports the collection. (Within 3 days of collection)

## Role 2

3. Recover the fluorocarbons in line with standards.
