
Roles performed by dismantlers in automotive recycling

- ◆ Japan's ELV (End-of-Life Vehicle) Recycling Law must be followed when dismantling vehicles.

 Dismantling shall not be performed without permission. Failure to obey the ELV Recycling Law may result in penalties including imprisonment or fines.

 [ELV Recycling Law: Chapter 8]
- Auto-dismantling businesses must obtain permission from municipalities in order to dismantle vehicles.
 [ELV Recycling Law: Chapter 3, Section 3]

Role 1

1. Collect the vehicle and confirm its chassis number.




