This guide follows the processing and practical task workflows of collection operators summarizing the necessary information (5 roles).



Roles Performed by Collection Operators in Automotive Recycling

- ◆ End-of-Life Vehicles (ELVs) must be handled in compliance with the Act on Recycling of End-of-Life Automobiles (ELV Recycling Law).

 Violating the ELV Recycling Law will result in penalties such as fines and imprisonment. [Chapter VIII]
- ♠ ELVs that have been collected may not be resold as used cars.
 Collection operators must confirm the vehicle owner's intent before determining whether to collect it as a used car or ELV.
- Registration with the local government is required in order to carry out collection operations for ELVs. [Chapter III, Section 1]

Practical Tasks Performed by Collection Operators in Automotive Recycling (Recommended Procedures)



Role 1

[Article 9]

1. Check the vehicle's chassis number and if it is equipped with fluorocarbons/airbags.

Check fluorocarbons





- 2. Confirm the deposit.
- *A deposit is required if the recycling fee has not been deposited

Role 2

[Article 9; Article 81, paragraph (1)]

- 3. Collect the ELV.
- 4. Report the collection. (Within 3 days of collection)

Role 3

[Article 80]

5. Issue Certificate of Collection.

8. Collection operator confirms that the ELV has been dismantled.

- 6. Deliver ELV for subsequent processing.
 - Equipped with fluorocarbons
 - → Fluorocarbon recovery operator
 - Not equipped with fluorocarbons
 - → Dismantler
- 7. Person in charge of report on movements reports delivery of the ELV. (Within 3 days of delivery)
